

Why Are Bicycle and Pedestrian Planning Important?

State and federal funding opportunities for bicycle and pedestrian facilities typically require that local agencies already have comprehensive plans for such projects in place. At this meeting, one of our speakers will present best practices in pedestrian master planning, from experience preparing such plans for areas as diverse as San Francisco, Fremont, and Alameda and Sonoma Counties.

Marin County has received a \$25 million federal grant for bicycle and pedestrian projects. Our other speaker will describe this program, highlighting the process to develop and select specific projects to fund.
